Things to note:

2. Please note the Code of Conduct that we all need to adhere to - players, parents, supporter, coaches and managers. I know there have been some issues with bad sportsmanship on the courts - PRNA is aware that this is happening in some age groups. Please continue to encourage our Brothers players to play the game with a good sporting attitude. If there are any problems please find me at the courts - I am there most Saturdays.
3. PRNA commenced TID (Talent Identification) in round 12 and will continue this over the remaining rounds. The PRNA TID reps will be wandering around watching players and taking notes. If a player has been identified, they will receive a letter inviting them to join further TID training in preparation for representative trials and selection.
